

## Earth Science Lab Requirements

During the year, you will complete required Earth Science labs for each topic in the curriculum.

To successfully fulfill the requirements for Regents Earth Science, your lab folder at the end of the year must contain all assigned labs completed with a passing grade. New York State Earth Science course requirements state that students must complete required lab work in order to be eligible to take the Regents exam in June.

Labs submitted for grading must have the following parts **IN ORDER**:

- 1) **Cover:** must have the lab number(s) and the title in the center. Must also have your name, Earth Science period, due date and teacher name in a block of copy at the lower right corner of the cover. You may decorate the cover if you wish.
- 2) **First page:** Your lab's first page is the title page of the printed lab (which includes instructions and vocabulary). You may write vocabulary definitions neatly by hand or type vocabulary and place it **AFTER** the first page of the lab.
- 3) **Body pages:** These may include charts, graphs, data tables, drawings or any other work the lab requires. Your teacher will tell you the order these pages must follow.
- 4) **Discussion questions pages:** **ALWAYS** come directly after body pages and before the lab conclusion page.
- 5) **Conclusion:** conclusions are written in class unless otherwise instructed. The conclusion page is always the last page of the lab report.

Please submit labs with all pages stapled together in the upper left corner. **DO NOT SUBMIT LABS IN PLASTIC COVERS!**

I.O.U forms must be submitted when labs are not turned in on time.
